Dr. Anyu holds a Ph.D. in Political from Howard University. He is a tenured professor of Public Management and Public Policy at the School of Business and Public Administration at the University of the District of Columbia, Washington, DC.

Dr. Anyu served as a Public Board Member on several **Foreign Service Selection Board and the Special Reconstituted Boards at United States Department of State.**

Dr. Anyu previously served as Associate Professor and Assistant Professor, and lecturer of political science at the University of the District of Columbia and Howard University from 1999 to 2012 and from 1997-2007 respectively.

Dr. Anyu has authored several scholarly peer reviewed articles and many newspaper articles on policy-related issues. Several of his articles have been extensively cited and read by many academics, practitioners and student across the globe His most recent book is entitled: *The lure of Chinese Money in Africa (2022)* His other published books include *Case Studies of Conflict in Africa (2013)*, *The Foreign Corrupt Practices Act: A Catalyst for Global Corruption Reforms (2007)*, *Democracy, Diamond and Oil: Politics in Africa Today (2006)* and *People on the Move (2004)*.

Dr. Anyu currently serves assistant editor at the *International Journal of Organizational Innovation*, published by University of Indiana Press. He served as guest editor at the *Sustainability Journal (2022)* He served as assistant editor and book review editor at the *Mediterranean Quarterly*, (2000-2013) a journal of global issues, published by Duke University Press.
